This mini-tour opportunity is perfect for families who are interested in testing out the touring experience with PCC on a smaller scale. Parents and caregivers are invited to apply to serve as chaperones, but there is no requirement to participate with your child.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

All payments will be handled directly through Pensacola Children's Chorus. PCC's standard financial policies apply.

Trip can be paid in full by April 15. Any pricing increases or decreases will be assessed by no later than May 15, 2025.

CANCELATION SCHEDULE

Cancelation must be received by Pensacola Children's Chorus in writing. **If cancelation notice is received...** On or before May 16, 2025

PAYMENT TERMS & PROCEDURES

Automatic Payments

After May 16, 2025

Trip participants may enroll in automatic payments through PCC's payment processing system. ACH bank drafts and credit cards are accepted. Credit cards will incur a 3.49% handling fee. ACH bank drafts will incur a 1.49% handling fee.

Manual Payment

Trip participants can submit cash/check/money order according to the payment schedule.

Click-to-Pay/Electronic Invoicing

Trip participants may enroll in click-to-pay electronic invoices. All click-to-pay invoices will incur a 3.49% processing surcharge.

Late Payments

Accounts which are delinquent for more than 30 days will be automatically assessed a 10% late fee. This fee is compounded for every additional 30 days that an invoice goes unpaid.

Delinquency

Accounts that have an overdue balance, including a balance due to late fees, will not be granted permission to board the motorcoach and/or will not receive a park admission ticket until the balance is paid.



CHAPERONE/NON-PERFORMER POLICY

The Pensacola Children's Chorus welcomes parents, family members, and friends to accompany us on this tour. If you are considering joining us on this trip, please review the following information:

CHAPERONE

Chaperones are an essential component of every tour. As an extension of staff leadership, chaperones ensure that PCC's standards of conduct are observed by all singers throughout the tour. Chaperoning is a great way to experience the trip through the eyes of our singers. The best chaperones play a crucial role in cultivating a positive and memorable tour experience.

A participating singer's family member can serve as a chaperone. Parents/guardians are preferred. Other family members (such as a grandparent, aunt/uncle, or older sibling over the age of 21) may be able to chaperone but must first interview with a member of the PCC staff. Because chaperones serve as caretakers of singers during the trip, they are required to pass a Level 2 background check and are carefully vetted by PCC staff members. If you are interested in becoming a chaperone, **please register for the trip**. You will not be charged until you have been contacted by a PCC staff member.

Please note that **if you wish to accompany your child on the trip, you must register as a <u>chaperone</u>, not a tagalong. As such, chaperones <u>may not</u> deviate from the scheduled itinerary, <u>nor</u> can they be responsible for any children/family members who are not enrolled as a PCC singer. (This stipulation especially applies to non-enrolled siblings, spouses, or extended family members. Chaperoning is a <u>job</u>, not a vehicle for a family outing.)**

Additionally, chaperones will be expected to part ways from their singer from time-to-time to participate in chaperone-only activities, as well as provide space for singers to build social bonds and shared experiences under the supervision of PCC staff.

TAGALONG

Due to the short nature of this trip, parents, caregivers, friends and family members who are not serving as chaperones are not invited to participate in this trip experience. However, this does not prevent friends and family to join us in OWA (valid park admission is required to view the performance). Regardless, participating singers must remain with PCC chaperone groups at all times. Furthermore, adults who are not a part of the touring group may not remove a singer from PCC supervision or attach themselves to a PCC chaperone group at any time.
