Performances on **August 2** in the afternoon and **August 3** in the morning.

Throughout the week, singers will engage in a wide variety of musical experiences, including large group choral singing, movement/dance, small group voice class, general music, world music, and music theory. Combined, these classes will provide a fast-paced immersion into the unique philosophy of the Pensacola Children’s Chorus—one that combines music and movement to bring out the best in each child and prepare them for future success.

WHAT TO BRING:

Each day of camp (Monday–Friday), a child should bring a **bag lunch** and **refillable water bottle**. Singers should also wear comfortable clothes and **flat, closed-toed, closed-back shoes** with the expectation that they will be dancing and moving for much of the day. Singers who plan to participate in water activities at the YMCA should bring a **bathing suit** and **towel**.

SATURDAY (8/2) PERFORMANCE INFORMATION:

Saturday's performance will occur at **2:00pm** in the sanctuary of the **First Baptist Church of Pensacola**. Singers will be asked to arrive at **12:00pm**. Singers are expected to wear their *Summer Festival* t-shirt (provided by PCC), blue jeans (no rips/tears), and comfortable shoes. This event is expected to end at 3:30pm.

Each participating singer will receive one (1) complimentary ticket for the Saturday performance. Additional tickets are \$10.00 each and can be purchased at pick-up and drop-off each day. Phone orders may be placed at any time by calling the PCC office at (850) 434-7760 during the normal business hours of 9:00am-5:00pm Monday-Thursday, or 9:00am-12:00pm on Friday. Cash, check (made out to "Pensacola Children's Chorus"), and credit cards are accepted. Please note that credit card transactions will incur an additional 3.49% handling fee.

SUNDAY (8/4) PERFORMANCE INFORMATION:

In the spirit of gratitude for our hosts, *Summer Festival* singers will participate in the August 3rd worship service at the **First Baptist Church of Pensacola**, which will commence at **10:45am**. Call time will be **9:30am**. Parents, friends, and family members are welcome to attend. Singers should wear the same uniform as the August 2nd concert (*Summer Festival* shirt, blue jeans, and comfortable shoes). This event is expected to end at 12:00pm.

MORNING DROP-OFF:

Each day will begin at the **First Baptist Church of Pensacola**. Please approach the church via Jackson Street and drive to the covered portico adjacent to the sanctuary (tallest part of the building). Singers will enter the doors underneath the portico. Cars should exit onto Palafox St. Please do not approach the covered portico from Palafox. Camp will start promptly at **9:30am**. Singers will be permitted to enter **as early as 8:30am**.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP:

Each afternoon, participants will be transported by PCC staff members to the **Bear Levin Studer Family YMCA** for supervised recreational time, including water activities. Singers can be picked up **as late as 6:00pm**.
